We will all be taking home a reading book! Each week we will be doing guided reading.

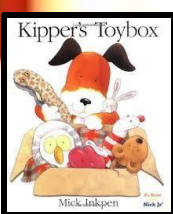
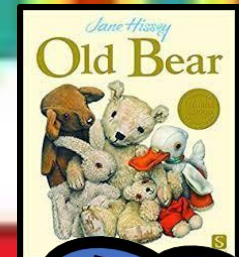
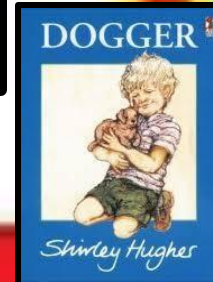
The Reception children will be performing a Christmas play.
