Science:

Exploring Materials

AT HOME: Can you test some objects in the bath? Do they float or sink?

Topic (History)

We will be learning about the **Fire of London** and looking at the differences between then and now.

Topic (Geography)

We will be learning that **London** is the Capital City of England and name famous landmarks.

Using **Scratch** on the iPads we will be creating characters, backgrounds and programming ways to make things move.
