Last term of Reception! We have so much to look forward to this term. We will be swimming, sports day, poetry competition, finding out about lighthouses and we might have some special visitors. All crammed into just 7 weeks!!

Topic

This term our topic is The Seaside. We will be finding out how the seaside has changed over the years, how lighthouses work and who lives in rock pools.

Jumpers and Coats

Please make sure that you have checked your children's jumpers still have their names clearly in them.

The children will need to have their jumpers in every day as they are often chilly after swimming. It's also handy if they have a light rain coat in school too, as we still go out to play if it rains and it's handy if it is raining at home time!!

PE Kits

Water Bottles

The children need to have water bottles in school with them everyday. The children have constant access to their water bottles all day. Please ensure that their bottles are clearly named.

Sun Hats

As the weather gets warmer and a bit more sunny please ensure that your child has a named sun hat that can be left in school. Our outside area is a real sun trap and the children love to spend lots of time out there in the summer.

Sun Cream

Please make sure all children have sun cream applied before school.

Unwell

As more colds and tummy bugs make an appearance, please make sure you keep your children off school if they are unwell, to stop germs spreading. If your child has an upset tummy please keep your child home for 48 hours after they were last poorly.

Reading

We have now moved onto level 4 with our phonics, words will become more challenging. We will also be learning new tricky words as the term progresses. Please keep up with **reading 3 times a week**. When reading with your child if they have sounded out a word and it appears on another page see if they can remember it! Can your child do secret sound talking? This term we are working on the children becoming fluent readers, can they read the sentence back to you?
